The Building World again met in Prague, at the FOR ARCH Trade Fair

The 16th year of the International Building Trade Fair "FOR ARCH" took place from Tuesday, 20 September, to Saturday, 24 September 2005, at the Prague Exhibition Centre in Letňany. FOR ARCH Praha 2005 was organised by ABF and the Trade Fair again confirmed the uniqueness and superior quality of the full-range professional event dedicated to the sectors of architecture and building industry.



At the hopelessly sold out exhibition areas of the Prague Exhibition Centre it was possible to see products of 1028 exhibiting firms from 15 countries of the world. The first responses of the exhibitors clearly indicate that this year's FOR ARCH has become one of the most successful years of the Trade Fair. The event was visited by 104,811 visitors, the accompanying programmes were attended by 1,684 professionals from 23 countries of the world, which means that the total number of visitors arriving to the Trade Fair achieved a record figure of 106,495 people, mostly professionals. The in-site survey of opinions of the visitors carried out during the Trade



de Fair showed a very positive fact for the exhibitors: **the participation of people with decision-making powers has increased.**

COMPETITION OF APPRENTICES OF BUILDING TRADES



The international final of the 9th year of the competition of apprentices of building trades (SUSO)[®]

The final round took place on 20–22 September with participation of the best teams from regional rounds held in Ostrava, České Budějovice, Brno, Prague, Litoměřice, Karlovy Vary and in Slovakia. In Hall no. 1, the FOR ARCH Trade Fair visitors had a possibility to admire skills of 62 competitors in the categories of bricklayer, tile setter, joiner, dry structure fitter and stonecutter - stone sculptor from 27 Czech and Slovak schools.

SUSO is supported by the Ministry of Industry and Trade, patronage is provided by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports, Economic Chamber of the Czech Republic, and newly also by the Association of Entrepreneurs in the Building Industry of the Czech Republic.

ABF, being the main organiser of SUSO, cooperates with the Occupational Safety Research Institute, Guild of Tile Setters of the Czech Republic, Association of Stonecutters and Stone Sculptors and with other professional associations. The competitions are supported from financial as well as material points of view by a number of firms. In the course of the final round, a new sponsor of

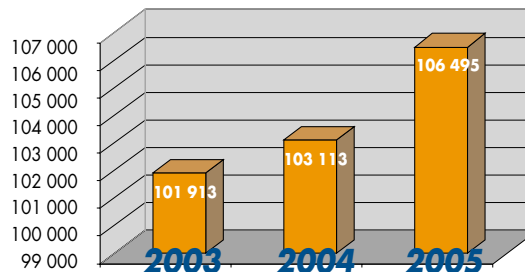

NUMBER OF COUNTRIES REPRESENTED

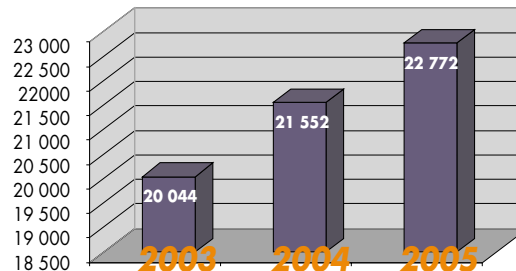

FOR ARCH confirms its international reputation.

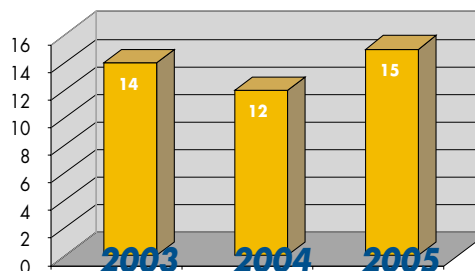
NUMBER OF VISITORS



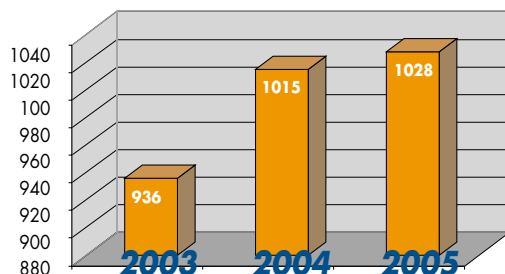
EXHIBITION AREA SOLD (in m²)



NUMBER OF COUNTRIES REPRESENTED



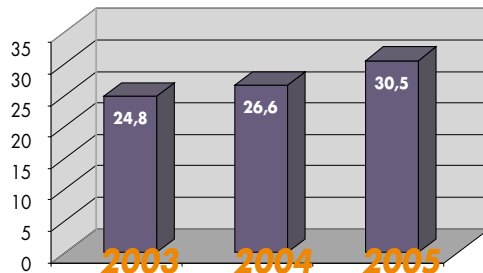
NUMBER OF EXHIBITORS

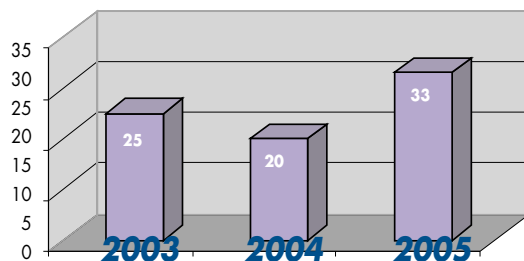
AVERAGE AREA OF EXPOSITIONS (in m²)

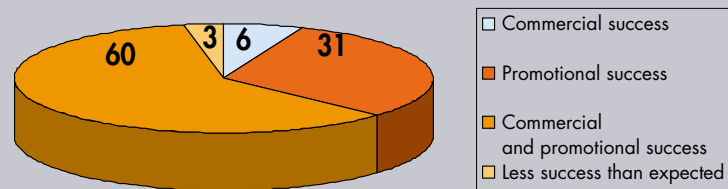

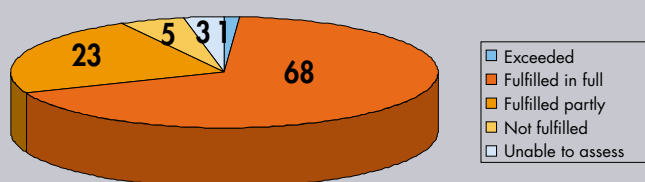
- Commercial or promotional success was registered at the Trade Fair by 97 % of exhibitors

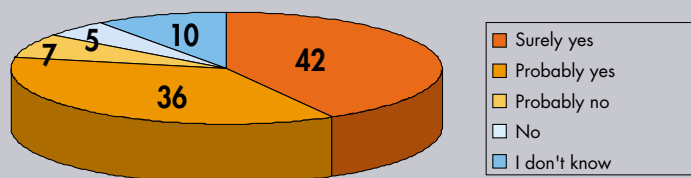
SUCCESS RATE ACHIEVED BY EXHIBITORS AT THE TRADE FAIR



FULFILLED EXPECTATIONS OF EXHIBITORS



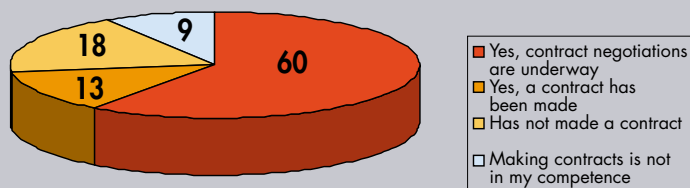
PARTICIPATION OF EXHIBITORS IN 2006



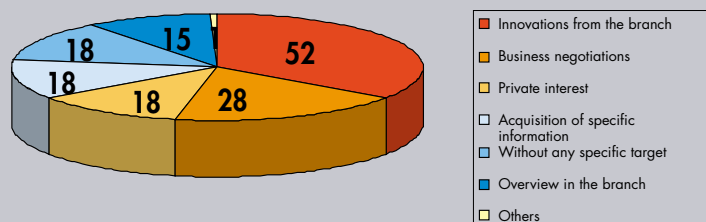

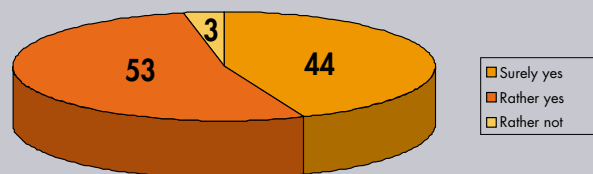

ENERGY PERFORMANCE OF BUILDINGS

Opening conference of the FOR ARCH 2005 Trade Fair, 20 September 2005, Žofín Palace

The core topic of the conference was presentation of Directive 2002/91/EC on the energy performance of buildings.

The French procedure of transposition of the Directive was presented by Pierre Viola from the Ministry of Transport, Constructions and Tourism. The specialists from the Building Research Establishment (BRE), Austrian Energy Agency (EVA), Deutsche Energie-Agentur (DENA) informed about the methods of transposition of the Directive into their national legal and technical regulations. The conference participants were made familiar with the current state of changes prepared in the assessment of the energy performance of buildings which are formed by the PHARE project outputs. The solver of the project is BRE in cooperation with the French Building Research Institute (CSTB) and the national partner ENVIROS CZ. The representative of the Intelligent Energy-Europe Agency (IEEA) for the Czech Republic provided comprehensive information about the agency activities and projects administered by the agency.

The conference programme was divided into topical sections:

- EPBD AND CHANGES IN LAW REGULATIONS
- METHODOLOGICAL PROCEDURES FOR DETERMINATION OF ENERGY PERFORMANCE OF BUILDINGS
- ENERGY CERTIFICATES OF BUILDINGS
- EXAMPLES OF BEST PRACTICES

The organiser of the conference was the **Ministry of Industry and Trade of the Czech Republic**, Department of Construction and Investment Development, in connection with the Department of Eco-Energy, the organisational work was performed by ABF, a.s. The **technical programme** and selection of presentations were ensured by the Preparatory Committee in the following composition:

Drahomír Růta**, Managing Director of Pražská energetika, a.s.; **Ing. Jan Růml**, Chairman of the Board of Directors of Plynoprojekt, a.s.; **Ing. Petr Holoubek** from the State Energy Inspection of the Czech Republic; **Ing. Josef Bubeník**, Director of the Czech Energy Agency and others.

In the evening, all speakers were invited to the festive evening party organised by ABF on the occasion of the handing over of prizes of the FOR ARCH 2005 Trade Fair, at the participation of the Prime Minister of the Government of the Czech Republic, Minister of Industry and Trade and Minister for Regional Development.





SALON OF INNOVATIONS AND INVESTMENTS

A simultaneous conference to FOR ARCH 2005, 20–24 September 2005, Prague Exhibition Centre in Letňany

The 2nd year of the Salon of Innovations and Investments focused on presentation of outputs of scientific and research work in practice, with a special emphasis on projects for the field of the building industry, was extended with a professional conference. Both parts of the project were supported and co-organised by the Ministry of Industry and Trade of the Czech Republic, Academy of Sciences of the Czech Republic and Czech technical University in Prague, which guaranteed a really high professional level of both the exhibition with the panel presentation and the conference programme. The aim of the 2nd year of the Salon of Innovations and Investments was to provide backgrounds for the establishment of contacts and links between scientific workplaces and entrepreneurial sectors.

EXHIBITION

The IBT project whose part was formed by a conference, workshop and exhibition presented the existing concepts and understanding of the meaning of the term “intelligent building”. The main topic of the conference was to present the possibilities of integration of individual control and monitoring systems in buildings to one superior control system while complying with demands on low-energy building activities, assurance of operation and modern administration of buildings, including the new management challenge area in a form known as Facility Management.

Invited speakers were represented by professionals from companies which represent the top in the field of suppliers of the systems for an intelligent building operation.

An introduction into the issues and a right explanation of the term “intelligent building” were presented by representatives of the Faculty of Civil Engineering of the Czech Technical University in Prague, Doc. Ing. Karel Kabele, CSc. and Prof. Ing. Miloslav Jokl, DrSc.

The participants could see a demonstrative example of an “intelligent building” within the framework of a workshop which took place in a unique construction, the future seat of the **National Integrated Air Traffic Control Centre (IATCC)** in Jeneč. This building was appraised by the award “Building of the Year 2005” and its model was presented within the framework of a separate exhibition exposition of the IBT project.

The conference agenda was divided into topic sections as follows:

- INTELLIGENT BUILDING
- FACILITY MANAGEMENT
- TELECOMMUNICATION

The organiser and manager of the IBT project is ABF a.s.

The conference was attended by 69 professionals from the numbers of developers, designers, investors and other technical specialists.

The conference was attended by 56 experts from the numbers of state administration and local self-government administration re-

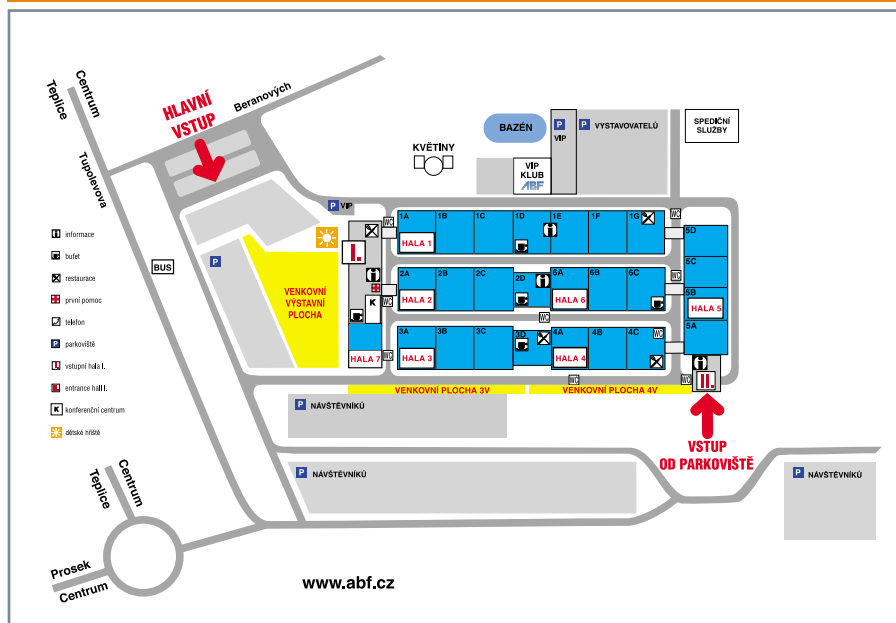

Prague Exhibition Centre in Letňany

The Prague Exhibition Centre in Letňany has undergone several significant improvements before this year's autumn trade fair season. PVA servis, which administers the exhibition centre, proceeds according to the long-term plan of upgrades, which serves for an increase in the comfort of both visitors and exhibitors. A principal improvement is represented by the complete renovation of Hall no. 4, which currently offers a representative exhibition area covering more than 4,200 m², newly constructed sanitary facilities and a restaurant facility. A significant improvement is formed also by the new concrete floor with an increased load bearing capacity in Hall no. 5, which makes it possible to present products for all firms manufacturing heavy products, such as fireplaces or stoves. The outdoor exhibition area was reinforced with an interlocking paver system. The 2nd entrance hall of the Trade Fair Centre has undergone further renovation, and this renovation was focused on the roofing of the entrance area, and the hall at present offers great comfort to the visitors coming from the external parking area. Both gastronomic zones have undergone minor upgrading treatments as well, together with VIP premises and other rest zones designed for both exhibitors and visitors.

Upgrading of the existing Prague Exhibition Centre in Letňany

Further improvements are prepared by PVA servis for the spring trade fair season 2006, this mainly concerns a renovation of Hall no. 2, which was commenced in 10/05. There will be created full-value and attractive exhibition premises with a surface area of 4,200 m² and 4,600 m², divided by a rest zone.

In 2006, the Centre will provide

- 34,200 m² of indoor exhibition premises;
- 6,000 m² of outdoor areas;
- 3,800 parking sites

and premises for organisation of accompanying programmes to the trade fairs.

The conference centre of PVA Letňany can offer one conference hall for 140 people and two halls for 40 people.

PRAGUE – A TRADE FAIR AND PERHAPS ALSO AN OLYMPIC



PRAGUE EXHIBITION CENTRE IN LETŇANY

The project has been a strategic intent of the Capital City of Prague since 1997 and has been developed on the basis of the following materials:

- Agreements concluded between the Capital City of Prague and ABF, a.s. of 10 December 1997
- Approved trade fair concepts of the Municipal Corporation of the Capital City of Prague of 28 June 2001
- Programme Declaration of the Council of the Capital City of Prague of 25 March 2003

OBJECTIVE: to open the 1st phase of the new Prague Exhibition Centre in Letňany which will provide approximately 40,000 m² of indoor exhibition premises and 10,000 m² of outdoor exhibition areas simultaneously with the putting of the Letňany Metro Station into operation.

In order to ensure implementation and operation of the Exhibition Centre thanks to which Prague belongs among the Trade Fair and Congress cities of Europe, PVA a.s. has been founded (up to now: 11 % Capital City of Prague, 89% ABF, a.s.).

In 2004 and 2005, PVA a.s. conducted negotiations, on the basis of authorisations from its owners (to find a strategic partner for the PVA project), gradually with more than twenty potential partners interested in participation in the PVA project. 12 of them presented a written offer. During April to July 2005, 8 applicants took part in consultations with both shareholders. The offers were assessed in August 2005 by the Board of Directors of PVA a.s. and then they were submitted to representatives of both shareholders for a final selection.

In September and October, the offers were discussed in the bodies of the two companies. During negotiations of 31 October 2005, at participation of Mr. Bém, Prague Mayor; Mr. Choděra, Deputy Mayor for Exhibition and Trade Fair Activities; Mr. Hulínský, Deputy Mayor for Finance Policy and statutory bodies of ABF, a.s., it was decided that the strategic partner of the PVA project will be, with a very high probability, the consortium of the companies :IMMORENT, Deutsche Messe AG Hannover, Global Capital Finance, Česká spořitelna, SKANSKA CZ.

The decision making process of the existing representatives of PVA a.s. shareholders with regard to selection of a strategic partner was based not only on the quality of the tender proposal submitted and on the credibility of potential partners, but also on the fact that the implementation of a modern trade fair, as well as multifunction centre in Prague – Letňany will support the candidature of Prague and of the Czech Republic for organisation of the Summer Olympic Games.

PRAGUE STRONGLY FOSTERS ITS POSITION AMONG THE TRADE FAIR CENTRES OF EUROPE

In 01/05, the PVA project was examined by the study which has been drawn up for the Capital City of Prague and for the Olympic Committee by Price Water House. The study stated that the halls are satisfactory for many Olympic disciplines.



On 22 September, 2005, the FOR ARCH Trade Fair was visited by a delegation of representatives of Hannover Messe, IMMORENT and Global Capital Finance in view of discussing the development of the European trade fair industry in which Prague is to play always a more important role.

Prague is predetermined to become a centre of Europe not only thanks to its geographic position, but also thanks to its abilities to attract high numbers of visitors to congresses and trade fairs through its historical and cultural heritage.
