## STAVBA ROKU 2005

The first day of the Trade Fair culminated at the traditional festive evening party. # COMPETITION OF APPRENTICES OF BUILDING TRADES

**SUSO**

**The international final of the 10<sup>th</sup> year of the competition of apprentices of building trades (SUSO)<sup>®</sup>**

Already the tenth final of the SUSO competition took place within the framework of the FOR ARCH Building Trade Fair on **19-21 September 2006** in the Hall 7 of the Prague Letňany Exhibition Centre. The competition participants were the best teams from regional rounds held in the academic year 2005/2006 in Ostrava, Olomouc, Prague, Litoměřice, Karlovy Vary and Slovakia. There were altogether **54 competitors in the categories of bricklayer, joiner, dry structure fitter and stone-cutter - stone sculptor from 24 Czech and Slovak schools.**

An innovation of this year's final was formed by the competition category "painter-varnisher-coater" during the organisation of which ABF, a.s., the Guild of Painters and Varnishers of the Czech Republic and sponsors joined their forces. The general sponsor was Primalex, a.s.

SUSO is supported by the Ministry of Industry and Trade, patronage is provided by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports, by the Economic Chamber of the Czech Republic, and by the Association of

Entrepreneurs in the Building Industry of the Czech Republic. ABF, being the main organiser of SUSO, cooperates with the Occupational Safety Research Institute, Association of Stonecutters and Stone Sculptors and with other professional associations. ## NUMBER OF VISITORS

The International Building Trade Fair FOR ARCH continues to keep the status of one of the most prestigious Prague trade fair events. This year it was visited by 103,069 visitors, 1786 of whom attended accompanying programmes as well.

## NUMBER OF EXHIBITORS

The most frequently monitored indicator of the trade fair is the number of exhibiting firms. **There were 987 exhibitors and co-exhibitors presenting their products and services this year.** This number includes also the exhibitors of new, associated trade fairs: FOR INVEST 26, FOR SPORT 28 and WOOD CONSTRUCTION 34 exhibitors.

## EXHIBITION AREA SOLD

Another important figure indicating the success of trade fairs is the volume of the exhibition areas sold. Concerning the 21,902 m<sup>2</sup> of the net exhibition area, 461 m<sup>2</sup> belonged to FOR INVEST, 930 m<sup>2</sup> belonged to FOR SPORT and 868 m<sup>2</sup> was dedicated to the WOOD CONSTRUCTION Trade Fair.

## NUMBER OF COUNTRIES REPRESENTED

FOR ARCH has confirmed its status of an international trade fair this year as well. It was possible to see flags of 12 countries flying at the exhibition centre.

The ABF Trade Fair Administration has decided to emphasise the new exhibition events at the FOR ARCH Trade Fair this year:

## FOR INVEST

**Presentation of investment opportunities in the Czech Republic**

A specialised exhibition designed for presentation of developing projects, investment offers of regions and cities, real estate agencies and financial institutions. Prague, as the Capital City of the Czech Republic, attracts many investors – visitors who welcomed presentations of multinational building firms, developers and investment companies at the trade fair.

## FOR SPORT

**Presentation of construction and equipment of sports facilities, swimming pools and gymnasiums**

This exhibition offers a possibility of integrated topical presentations of firms from the field of sports facility constructions or renovations, sports surfaces, complete equipment, systems and maintenance. An impulse for the organisation of this specialised event is formed especially by the growing trend in the sports facility constructions in the follow-up to a healthier living style of inhabitants or changes in legislation relating to safety of children's playgrounds. The new interesting opportunities are connected also with the possibility of organising the Olympic Games in Prague.

## WOOD CONSTRUCTION

**Exhibition section focussed on progressive constructions of wood**

This exhibition section of the FOR ARCH Trade Fair was a partial project of the complete programme "Wood" of the ABF company, whose part was formed by a conference and publication project as well. The aim of this programme was to present wood as a strategic material whose possibilities and use as a renewable raw material are not fully recognised in the Czech Republic yet.





## The Letňany Metro Station in construction opened for visitors

During the term of the 17th International Building Trade Fair FOR ARCH, the visitors as well as all people living in Prague could use the five days for visiting the premises of the Letňany Station situated on the Metro Line C. The occasion to go down into the underground vestibule of this final station of the route IV (line C 2) and into a part of one of the single-track tunnels driven through was used from 19 to 23 September by approximately 4,500 people interested in this transport construction.

The event which was an official accompanying programme of the trade fair was prepared by its organisers together with the Metrostav company.



# HIGH RISES AND PRAGUE

## Andel's Hotel Prague 18 September 2006

The conference with international participation opened the polemics focussed on the topic of incorporation of new architectonic and urban elements into the historical parts of cities and towns, especially the question whether it is suitable to construct there skyscrapers or not. The speeches at the conference were given by leading Czech experts and by specialists from Tallinn, Warsaw, Bratislava and Shanghai. The participants included also journalists, representatives of civic associations as well as ordinary Prague people interested especially in the opinions on the solution of the Prague District of Pankrác.
