# ABF, a.s. Business Terms and Conditions for the Participation of Exhibitors at the FOR ARCH 2009, FOR ELEKTRO 2009, FOR INVEST 2009 and FOR WOOD 2009 Trade Fairs

## Article I. - Definition of terms

**Organiser:** ABF, a.s. Václavské náměstí 29, 111 21 Praha 1 (hereinafter referred to as ABF)  
**Exhibitor:** Legal entities and natural persons to whom ABF confirmed their participation at the trade fair or exhibition

**Agency:** The firm which represents the Exhibitor and intermediates their participation at the trade fair.

**Implementing firm:** The firm which implements the exhibition exposition for the Exhibitor or for the agency.

## Article II. - Participation at the Trade Fairs, assignment of areas and terms of payment

1) The basic precondition for the participation at the Trade Fair is the delivery of the properly completed Binding Application to ABF within the deadline and the payment of the advancement for the area required + the registration fee within the due date stated in the invoice by the closing date. ABF decides about the acceptance, reduction or refusal of the order and is not obliged to explain its decision.

2) After the receiving of the Binding Application, ABF will send to the Exhibitor a confirmation of its receipt and an advance invoice for the exhibition area and registration fee for the exhibiting firm. **The prices for 1 m<sup>2</sup> are stated on page 1 and their amounts are subject to the date of payment.** The invoice for the area in a full amount will be issued to the firms registered from 30 April 2009. From 1 May 2009, services will be invoiced together with the price for the area.

3) After the settlement of the invoices and final processing of the orders, the Exhibitor will receive a raster of the exhibition areas with the marking of their location. **ABF reserves the right to reduce the ordered area, to change its shape and location - the order of the participation is binding for the Exhibitor also in this case.**

4) The advance invoice for the ordered services will be sent before the beginning of the Trade Fairs and its settlement will be a precondition for the beginning of the assembly of the exposition. The final invoice with deduction of advances will only be sent after the finishing of the Trade Fairs.

5) If the Exhibitor fails to settle the fees for the lease of the area and the registration fee in the full amount within the deadline required, ABF will confirm the lease of the area to another applicant without the original client being entitled to claim any possibly incurred expenses from ABF. If the confirmed area is not available to the Exhibitor for reasons caused by the Organiser of the Trade Fair, the Exhibitor is entitled to the reimbursement of the lease charge paid. The Organiser will not accept and will not indemnify any claims for damages which the Exhibitor could have incurred for this reason. All the prices are stated as VAT exclusive.

### 6) The basic price of the lease and the Registration Fee include:

Rental for the area during the assembly, Trade Fair and dismantling, insertion into the Trade Fair Catalogue to the extent of data stated in the Order of Record into the Catalogue, insertion into the orientation system of the Trade Fairs, five Exhibitor's Cards for the firms with an ordered area up to 30 m<sup>2</sup> + one Exhibitor's Card for every 10 m<sup>2</sup> commenced (including a part of this area) exceeding the area of 30 m<sup>2</sup>, Assembly/Dismantling Cards for the Implementation Teams, Trade Fair Catalogue, free of charge registration in the Building Information System "e-stav".

### 7) The basic price of the lease and the Registration Fee do not include:

External walls of the stand, nor any other equipment of the stand, nor the walls of the neighbouring stands, other records of the firm - i.e. branch offices, divisions, business representations, etc.

8) For each of the other firms which the Exhibitors will present in their expositions (by the presentation of exhibits, with an advertisement panel, company logo, commercial name, folders, video programmes, etc.), the Exhibitor is obliged to pay the Co-Exhibitor's Registration Fee. The firm properly registered in this way will be presented in the Trade Fair Catalogue to the full extent as the Exhibitor. In the case of any breach of this principle, the Exhibitor will be obliged to pay the Co-Exhibitor's registration Fee in a double amount during the Trade Fairs.

### 9) Cancellation Conditions

If the Exhibitor cancels their participation, ABF will retain from the advance payment the below specified percentages from the price of fulfilment, depending on the term of cancellation of the Binding Application:

20 % on the cancellation of the Binding Application in the term from **11 May to 31 May 2009, inclusive**

40 % on the cancellation of the Binding Application in the term from **1 June to 30 June 2009, inclusive**

80 % on the cancellation of the Binding Application in the term from **1 July to 16 August 2009, inclusive**

100 % on the cancellation of the Binding Application in the term from **17 August 2009** to the beginning of the Trade Fairs.

The Cancellation Conditions shall apply to the partly cancelled area as well (reduction of the originally requested area). The firm whose Binding Application for Participation has been delivered to ABF will be obliged to pay (at a level of 100%) the cancellation fees in the case of cancellation of the participation or its non-participation at the Trade Fair without an official cancellation even in the case that such a firm has not paid any advance invoice or another invoice. The cancellation of participation must always be made in writing. **The Registration Fees shall be forfeited in full amount, regardless of the term of the cancellation of the Binding Application or in the case of non-participation without cancellation.**

## Article III. - Deadline of Applications and Orders

It is necessary to send the Binding Application, Binding Order of Technical Services, Order of Registration of Other Firms - Co-Exhibitors, Order of Records into the Catalogue and possibly the Order of Erection of the Stand and Equipment to the ABF correspondence address: **ABF, a.s., Mimoňská 645, 190 00 Praha 9**, within the terms of individual closing deadlines. We recommend that all the correspondence should be sent by registered mail.

## Article IV. - Exhibition area

ABF leases:

- **indoor exhibition area** without any equipment, with a possible power supply, water pipeline, sewerage, telephone, Internet and cleaning facilities on the basis of the Application. The minimum size of the exhibition area is 3x3 m, i.e. 9m<sup>2</sup>.

- **outdoor exhibition area** on the dedicated free areas of the Exhibition Centre. The minimum size of the exhibition area is 3x3 m, i.e. 9m<sup>2</sup>. (Attention: - in the case of outdoor stands it is necessary to count on an overlapping of the roof above the stand - the roof must not interfere into the neighbouring area).

If the exhibiting firm itself does not provide for the stand or if it does not order its erection from ABF, it will have only the ordered exhibition area without borders at its disposal. The architectural concept in the exhibition halls counts on the implementation of the classical rectangular exhibition raster, within which the following exhibition areas will be available:

- **row areas** with a free front side

- **corner areas** with two open sides - along which the visitors walk

- **U-shape areas** (front) with three open sides - along which the visitors walk

- **island areas** where all of the four sides are free.

The shapes of expositions are not differed for outdoor areas (it depends on the specific place, we recommend you to count on a row exposition).

### Height of halls, loading of floors

For a limited number of expositions it is possible to implement two-storey stands, as well as height dominants. The height usable oscillates from 3.0 to 8.0 m (depending on the specific place of the exposition in the raster). The maximum height of exhibits for transport to the halls is 3 m. The hall floor in terms of the length is at a ratio of 1/140. The ba-

sic load bearing capacity is 600 kg/m<sup>2</sup>. At a special order in the Binding Application it is possible to ensure, on an individual basis, the floor reinforcement - it is necessary to consult this with ABF. The maximum weight of the exhibit is 2.5t.

## Article V. - Safety

The Exhibitors are not allowed to store or use in their expositions or in the territory of the Exhibition Centre any combustible and radioactive substances, exploding materials, acids, poisons and other health harming substances. The Exhibitors are obliged to observe the technical, fire and safety regulations which are in force.

**At the Exhibition Centre, ABF is not responsible towards the Exhibitors or their Co-exhibitors for any losses, destruction or any damage concerning the exhibits, equipment and outfit of the stands, goods, packages, packing materials whatsoever, whether the loss, destruction or other damage occurred during the assembly, dismantling, transportation or during the Trade Fair.**

## Article VI. - Insurance

From 2006 onwards, the insurance of expositions during Trade Fairs is arranged for automatically within the framework of the services provided by ABF, at a lump-sum advantageous price of **CZK 850.-** (VAT exclusive).

The insurance will apply for all the time of Trade Fairs, including assembly (except for the premature assembly) and dismantling.

### Scope of insurance:

- **Comprehensive natural hazards insurance** - indemnification limit: **CZK 5,000,000**, deductible CZK 5000.-

- **Theft risk insurance (theft, robbery)** - indemnification limit: **CZK 5,000,000**, deductible CZK 5000.-

- **Simple theft insurance** - indemnification limit: **CZK 100,000**, deductible CZK 5000.-

- **Third party liability insurance** - indemnification limit: **CZK 1,000,000**, deductible CZK 1000.-

**In the case of theft, thievery and other suspicion of a crime commitment, the insured is obliged to report such an event without any delay to the Police of the Czech Republic and to have the Damage Report issued.**

For further details about insurance see the Order Catalogue of Services. The Exhibitors have a possibility to order an individual safeguarding of their expositions directly from the Exhibition Centre (for contacts see the Order Catalogue of Services).

## Article VII. - Technical and fire regulations, energy usage regulations and directive for the use of temporary electrical installations

The Exhibitors are obliged to observe, during the assembly, in the entire course of the Trade Fairs and during the dismantling, generally binding law regulations of the Czech Republic, EU, as well as technical standards for the above mentioned areas including work safety regulations and handling all technical equipment. Furthermore, the Exhibitors are obliged to observe appropriate fire regulations valid for individual exhibition areas and the instructions of the authorised members of the fire assistant service and of the ABF staff. Temporary electrical devices must be in accordance with the ČSN 341090 standard and must comply with all other electro-technical regulations in force. The electrical installation works can only be carried out by a firm duly authorised to do so, i.e. possessing the "Certificate of Competence according to the Law No. 174/1968 Coll., Art. 4(f) and Art 3(2) of the Czech Work Safety Authority (ČUBP) and Czech Mining Authority (ČBU) Regulation No. 20/1979 Coll."

## Article VIII. - Promotion, advertising

1) The Exhibitors are only authorised to advertise their products or services in their own expositions.

2) Any placement of billboards, eye catchers, banners, as well as distribution of printed and other materials out of the stand is only permitted for consideration and subject to previous written approval following negotiations with ABF. Any unauthorised placement of advertising carriers, eye catchers on vehicles, gluing of promotional and information materials out of the company's own exposition, on windows, walls, floors or columns of the halls is forbidden. The Trade Fair Administration is authorised to forbid or remove at the Exhibitor's expense all advertisements which do not correspond to the above listed paragraphs.

3) During the Fairs it is permitted to perform audio-visual, acoustic, musical, dancing and other productions for the time not exceeding 8 minutes once an hour, and only provided that the other Exhibitors will not be disturbed by the operation of these facilities. On the limits of the Trade Fair stand it is not allowed to exceed the noise level of 70 dB, within the meaning of the Government regulation no. 502/2000 Coll. on protection of health from adverse impacts of noise and vibrations, as amended. In order to be able to carry out musical production on the exposition, the Lessee is furthermore obliged to apply for approval from the competent collective administrator of copyrights (such as OSA, INTERGRAM) within the meaning of the Act no. 121/2000 Coll., Copyright Act, as amended. All the methods of performance on the actual exhibition area or out of it (such as machinery and equipment in operation, musical production, etc.) are subject to the approval by the Trade Fair Administration.

If these conditions are not complied with or in the case that the productions cause noise, dust, pollutants, vibrations, endanger the safety of visitors and Exhibitors or if they limit or interfere in the Trade Fair operation, the Exhibitor may have to pay a fine amounting to CZK 5,000.- and in the case of a repeated breach it will be forbidden for the breaching Exhibitor to operate all such productions.

## Article IX. - Basic preconditions for the erection of the stand The erection of the Stand is offered and carried out by ABF.

The Exhibitors who will not make any use of this offer and who prefer to ensure the erections of their stands by themselves or through their agencies are obliged to submit the ground plan and front view of the stand with the marking of dominant heights, as well as with the marking of power, water and sewerage system lines, for approval to ABF, not later than 31 July 2009 and to announce the implementing firm. The Exhibitors are obliged to maintain the raster of the exhibition area, i.e. they may not exceed the designated area with anything from the ground plan point of view and the same applies to the dominant heights which are shifted out (Important! - the roofs of outdoor stands generally exceed their ground plan).

## Article X - Final provisions

All complaints on the part of Exhibitors towards ABF for the time of stand assembly and course of the Trade Fairs must be submitted in writing to the ABF Trade Fair Administration Director or to the authorised representative before the end of the Trade Fairs or during the dismantling work until it is completed.

Any other claims on the part of Exhibitors towards ABF can be applied for in writing within 2 weeks after the end of the Fairs. Any possible claims of the Exhibitors will cease to exist upon the expiration of 6 months after the end of the Fairs.

**The Business Terms and Conditions form an integral part of the Binding Application for participation (page 1a), the Technical Terms and Conditions form an integral part of the Binding Order of Technical Services (page 2a), other general information and Assembly and Dismantling Instructions form a part of the Order Catalogue of Services. The Exhibitors are obliged to make themselves familiar with these documents and to instruct all the staff taking part in the assembly, operation and dismantling of their expositions accordingly, with regard to the Business Terms and Conditions, Technical Terms and Conditions, Assembly and Dismantling Instructions and other regulations of the ABF Trade Fair Administration.**
